BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 251 of the City of Golden, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit Section 2. That no dog shall be kept or harbored within the City Limit, of the City of Golden, Colorado, unless the owner, keeper or person in charge of any such animal person in charge of any such animal person in charge of any such animal shall, before the First day of May of each year, pay to the City of Golden (he sum of Three and 50/100 (\$3.50) Dollars for each and every nale dog and spayed female dog and every unspayed female dog owned kept or barboard. The owned kept or barboard. The owned kept or barboard. owned, kept or harbored. The owner, keeper or person in charge of any dog or dogs shall also cause to duy dog or dogs shall also cause to be placed upon the neck of every dog so owned, kept or harbored, a collar made of durable material, having attached thereto a metal tag to be furnished by the City Clerk-Treasurer, the number of such tag corresponding with the number of the license to be issued to the owner, keeper or person in charge of the day of the corresponding to the corresponding to the day of the da the dog or dogs. Said collar with the tag attached thereto shall be kept on each dog at all times. That the City Clerk-Treasurer shall issue to the owner, keeper or person in charge of a dog a dupicate license tag to replace lost or stolen

tags upon payment of 25 cents. Section 2. That Ordinance Num-bered 251 of the City of Golden, be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of Section 13 which reads as follows:

Section 13. Every owner, keeper or person in charge of any such animal who shall fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any of the terms or provisions of this ordinance or who shall violate any of such terms or provisions shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.
