

ORDINANCE NO. 226

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE KEEPING AND HARBORING OF DOGS AND PROVIDING LICENSE FEES THEREFOR AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 129.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That no dog shall be kept or harbored within the city limits of the City of Golden, Colorado, unless the owner, keeper or person in charge of any such animal shall, before the first day of May of each year, pay to the City of Golden the sum of three (\$3.00) Dollars for each and every male dog and spayed female and ten (\$10.00) Dollars for each and every female dog owned, kept or harbored. The owner, keeper or person in charge of any dog or dogs shall also cause to be placed upon the neck of every dog so owned, kept or harbored, a collar made of durable material, having attached thereto a metal tag, to be furnished by the City Clerk, the number of such tag corresponding with the number of the license to be issued to the owner, keeper or person in charge of the dog or dogs. Said collar with the tag attached thereto shall be kept on each dog at all times.

Section 2. The owner, keeper or person in charge of any dog brought into the City of Golden after the first day of May of any year, shall immediately procure a license for such animal as hereinabove provided.

Section 3. Every owner, keeper or person in charge of any dog who shall fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any of the terms or provisions of this ordinance or who shall violate any of such terms or provisions shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.

Section 4. Ordinance number 129 adopted October 4, 1928, is hereby repealed.
