ORDINANCE NO. 938

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.04.008 OF THE GOLDEN REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1965 RELATING TO WATER SERVICE CONTRACTS FOR NON-COMMITTED AREAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Sub-section (b) (3) of Section 13.04.008 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby repealed and reenacted as follows

13.04.008 Application and Contract for Water Service. . . .

- (b) Non-committed areas. . . .
- (3) The water service contract shall delineate the water permit fees due the City as a result of the development. The contract shall also include, where applicable, payment by the applicant of pro rata share of additional expenses incurred or to be incurred by the City due to unusual development designs, location, and/or revision to the City's master plan facilities required because of service to the applicant's development.

Where City Council so requires the contract shall include one of the following provisions:

- (i) Water rights owned or to be acquired by the applicant, in an amount sufficient to meet the needs of the development, shall be deeded to the City.
- (ii) If the City determines that water rights deeded to the City are not sufficient to serve the water needs of applicant's development the City Council may then consider fees in lieu of water rights for the remainder of the required water needs.
- (iii) If the applicant does not own or is unable to acquire water rights acceptable to the City, the City Council may then consider fees in lieu of water rights up to the maximum of the required water needs of applicant's development.

Water rights tendered to the City will be evaluated by the city's water engineer and water attorney who will determine if said water rights would meet the required needs of the development. Given said information City Council will be the sole judge as to whether the tendered water rights will be accepted.

The City shall credit the applicant from System Development Fees collected from applicant's development the value of water rights provided. The value of the water rights will be determined by the City of Golden after consultation with the City's water engineer and water attorney.

If fees in lieu of water rights are accepted City Council will consider credits of said fees to System Development Fees of said development with a maximum credit limitation of 50% of said System Development fees.

The wherein maximum period system development fee credits will be provided is seven (7) years from the date of the contract, unless otherwise allowed by City Council and provided for in the contract. The contract shall provisions include concerning the permitted the rebates developer from system development fees realized from other customers tapping a service pipe onto distribution or transmission facilities, furnished by the developer. Finally, the contract shall include such other matters as the city attorney deems relevant.

Section 2. Any ordinances or portions of ordinaces in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
