## ORDINANCE NO. 891

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD WITHIN THE CITY OF GOLDEN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, as amended, are hereby amended by the addition of Chapter 18.54, as follows:

## PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

18.54.050 Duties of Board

18.54.010 CREATION, APPOINTMENT, TERMS. There is created a Parks and Recreation Board for the City of Golden which board shall be comprised of seven members each of whom shall be a resident of the city. The seven members of the board shall be appointed by the Mayor of the city, appointment of whom shall be confirmed by the majority of the council. All members of the board shall serve without compensation, unless the council shall be resolution establish a compensation and shall not hold any other municipal office, except that one of the members may be a member of the planning commission.

The terms of the members of the board shall be for a period of two years or until their successor takes office, except that the initial appointments made during 1982 wherein seven members shall be appointed, four members shall be appointed for one year and three members shall be appointed for two years.

- 18.54.020 AUTHORITY TO ADOPT REGULATIONS. The Parks and Recreation Board shall have authority to adopt rules of procedure governing its proceedings and will conduct all of its proceedings in accordance with such rules.
- 18.54.030 MEETINGS. The Parks and Recreation Board shall meet at least once each calendar month in regular meeting at a time and place it shall by order designate. It may also hold special meetings from time to time as it shall deem necessary; special meetings shall be at the call of the chairman of the board, or on request of three members. A complete record shall be kept at the city offices of all proceedings of the board, which record shall be available for public examination at all times.

In the event there is no business pending before the board the regular monthly meeting may be dispensed with.

long term plan for the growth and development of parks and recreational facilities within the city, within the meaning and the spirit of the city's Growth and Development Policy Plan.

(b) In carrying out its duties, the Parks and Recreation Board shall have authority to conduct open public hearings, conduct investigations, studies and surveys, prepare maps, charts, exhibits, and reports as shall be necessary; and do and perform all other acts and duties necessary to the promotion of public interest and understanding of its programs and plans. Whenever a public hearing is held before the Parks and Recreation Board, public notice shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the city at least seven days prior to such hearing.

Section 2. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
