ORDINANCE NO. 329

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ZONING THE CITY OF GOLDEN, REGULATING THE USES OF REAL PROPERTY AND AMENDING OR-DINANCE NO. 256 OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

OF GOLDEN.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN. COLORADO:

Section 1. That section nine (9) of Ordinance Number 256 of the City of Golden, be and is hereby amend-

ed as follows:

section 9. NON-CONFORMING USES. The lawful use of real property existing at the time of the adoption of this ordinance, although such use does not conform to the provisions hereof, may be continued, subject to the following provisions and conditions:

That such non-conforming use a. That such non-conforming use may not be changed in nature or character unless and until application to change the nature or character thereof shall have been duly made to and approved by the Board of Adjustment of the City of Golden

If such non-conforming use is b. If such non-conforming use is discontinued for a period of six (6) consecutive months, any further or subsequent use of said property shall be in conformity with the provisions of said ordinance Number 256 and amendments thereto.

c. Such non-conforming use may be extended throughout the building, provided no structural alterations except those required by law or ordinance or as provided herein

are made thereto.

Any such building or structure may be repaired whenever such repair shall be necessary or convenient to the use of such building and in event any such building is de-stroyed or damaged to the extent of stroyed or damaged to the extent of its assessed valuation, such non-conforming use may be continued provided that the building be reconstructed to conform to the set-back, side and back yourd and height back, side and back yard and height provisions of the District in which

it is located.

The non-conforming use of land, where no buildings of more than Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars assessed valuation is in existence at the time of the passage of this ordinance, shall revert to a use conforming with this ordinance within a period of five (5) years after the adoution of this ordinance ter the adoption of this ordinance for residential use, and three (3) years for commercial use.
