

**ORDINANCE NO. 259**

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF TWENTY-THIRD (23rd) STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all of that portion of Twenty-Third (23rd) Street described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the most southerly corner of Lot Six (6), Block 4, Bunzel's Addition to the City of Golden, Jefferson County, Colorado; thence North  $54^{\circ} 33' 55''$  East, 14 feet to a point which is the true point of beginning; thence South  $30^{\circ} 04' 27''$  East 3.67 feet to a point; thence North  $54^{\circ} 33' 55''$  East, 96 feet to a point; thence North  $30^{\circ} 04' 27''$  West, 3.67 feet to a point, which point is the most easterly point of Lot Six (6) in said Block 4; thence South  $54^{\circ} 33' 55''$  West, 96 feet to the true point of beginning, containing 352 square feet, more or less.

be and the same is hereby vacated and abolished as a public street, and therefore and the fee title thereof and thereto shall vest as by law in such cases made and provided.
