ORDINANCE NO. 666

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING EACH INDIVIDUAL LIVING UNIT TO OBTAIN INDIVIDUAL WATER TAP AND TO PAY AN INDIVIDUAL WATER TAP FEE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Chapter 13.04, Golden Revised Ordinances, 1965, hereby is amended by the addition of a new section to read as follows:

13.04.185, Individual Units to Obtain Taps. Each individual living unit, whether a single family residence, part of a multiple family dwelling unit, or individual mobile home, shall pay an individual water tap fee as set forth herein.

With the consent of the City Manager, upon his written approval, individual meters need not be supplied and billing may be maintained through the master meter for the various living units within the individual development, but the tap fees shall be established on an individual basis.
