ORDINANCE NO. 884

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE RETAIL SALES AND USE TAX REFUND FOR THE ELDERLY AND ALLOWING PRO-RATION OF THE REFUND UPON THE DEATH OF AN ELIGIBLE PERSON

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 3.06.070 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, as amended, is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

"3.06.070 Death of Applicant. If an otherwise eligible applicant dies prior to filing an application, his or her estate is entitled a refund of \$1.50 for each eligible 30 day period up to the date of death."

Section 2. Any ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
