Section 2. That those officers and
employees employed by the City of
Golden prior to September 1. 1955, be
compensated in accordance to their respective position Range Number Classification as outlined herein by Step E on or after January 1, 1957.

Section 3. That those officers and

employees who shall be employed by the City of Golden after September 1, 1955, shall be compensated on or after January 1, 1957 in accordance with their respective Position Range Number Classification as determined at the time of their employment and shall start under Step "A" for a six (6) month probationary period; thereafter, and upon the recommendation of the respective Department Head and approval of the City Manager, be raised to Step "B", "C", "D", and "E", in intervals of successive six (6) month periods, providing however, that in cases of previous applicable experience in new employees or extraordinarily in new employees or extraordinarily meritorious conduct on the job, a raise to the next step in the particular Position Range may be granted.
