

ORDINANCE NO. 272

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SOLICITORS AND THE DISTRIBUTORS OF ADVERTISING MATTER AND PROVIDING LICENSE FEES THEREFOR AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 159.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, either as principal or agent, to engage in the business, within the City of Golden, of going from place to place, or from house to house, soliciting and taking orders for the sale and future delivery of manufactured goods, wares and merchandise, without first procuring a license so to do from the City Clerk-Treasurer, and paying therefor the sum of twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per annum, provided, however, that the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to persons who solicit or take orders exclusively from merchants, business houses and places, manufacturing concerns, or from public or semi-public agencies and institutions.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, either as principal or agent, to distribute any hand bills, dodgers or other printed or written advertising matter, within said City, without first procuring a license so to do from the City Clerk-Treasurer, and paying therefor the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each and every day, or fraction of a day for which said license shall be issued, or the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per annum.

Section 3. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 159, passed November 5, 1937, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
