

ORDINANCE NO. 239

AN ORDINANCE FIXING DAY AND TIME OF THE REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Golden shall be held on the first Thursday in each month, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M.; provided, however, that said first Thursday is not a legal holiday, in which event the meeting shall be held on the second Thursday of said month; provided further, that the City Council may hold special or adjourned meetings at any time it may, in its discretion deem proper.

Section 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 3. WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
