

ORDINANCE NO. 385

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 1956 AND APPROPRIATING SUMS FOR DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1956, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1956, IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATUTES OF THE STATE AND ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 88, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1953 the City Manager of the City of Golden has submitted to the City Council a budget estimate of the revenues of said city and the expenses of conducting the affairs thereof for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1956 and ending December 31, 1956; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received said City Manager's estimate and held a public hearing thereon; and

WHEREAS, after a full and final consideration of the public hearing it is the opinion of the Council that the budget as filed should be approved and adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN:

Section 1. That the budget estimate of the revenues of the City of Golden and expenses of conducting the affairs thereof for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1956 and ending December 31, 1956, as submitted by the City Manager of said city, be, and the same is in all things adopted and approved as the budget estimate for defraying the expenses and liabilities against said city for the ensuing year of 1956.

Section 2. That the sum of \$24,298.80 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund for the payment of salaries, maintenance and operation, and capital outlay of the general government as hereinafter itemized, to-wit:

Section 3. That the sum of \$47,939.21 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund for the payment of salaries, maintenance and operation, and capital outlay of the Department of Public Safety as hereinafter itemized, to-wit:

Section 4. That the sum of \$78,439.48 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund for the payment of salaries, maintenance and operation, and capital outlay of the Department of Public Works as hereinafter itemized, to-wit:

TOTAL GENERAL FUND

APPROPRIATION \$150,677.49

Section 5. That the sum of \$80,330.26 is hereby appropriated out of the Water and Sewer Utility Fund for the payment of salaries, maintenance and operation, and capital outlay of the Water Division.

Section 6. That the sum of \$43,371.94 is hereby appropriated out of the Water and Sewer Utility Fund as a Reserve for Water Construction and Development; expenditures from this fund to be approved by the City Council by either ordinance or resolution.

Section 7. That the sum of \$44,000 is hereby appropriated out of the Water and Sewer Utility Fund for payment of Water Extension Bond Issue Redemption due in 1956.

Section 8. That the sum of \$7,742.50 is hereby appropriated out of the Water and Sewer Utility Fund for payment of Water Extension Bond Issue Interest due in 1956.

Section 9. That the sum of \$19,065.42 is hereby appropriated out of the Water and Sewer Utility Fund for the payment of salaries, maintenance and operation, and capital outlay of the Sewer Division.

Section 10. That the sum of \$8,309.58 is hereby appropriated out of the Water and Sewer Utility Fund as a Reserve for Sewer Construction.

TOTAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITY FUND APPROPRIATION, \$202,819.70.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
