

ORDINANCE NO. 1020

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$40,120.00 FROM
CONTINGENCY AND APPROPRIATING \$40,120.00
TO THE BUDGET OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN,
COLORADO:

Section 1. The City Council determines that certification
by the City Manager shows there is available in Contingency a sum
in excess of \$40,120.00.

Section 2. The budget of the Police Department does not
include funds for the purchase of 3 necessary police cars and 1
motorcycle and it is necessary to transfer this money from
Contingency for this expenditure.

Section 3. The City Council has determined that it is in
the best interest of the City to provide the requested funds.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from
Contingency the sum of \$40,120.00 and to appropriate \$40,120.00
to the budget of the Police Department.
