AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$40,120.00 FROM CONTINGENCY AND APPROPRIATING \$40,120.00 TO THE BUDGET OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

- Section 1. The City Council determines that certification by the City Manager shows there is available in Contingency a sum in excess of \$40,120.00.

- Section 3. The City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to provide the requested funds.
- Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from Contingency the sum of \$40,120.00 and to appropriate \$40,120.00 to the budget of the Police Department.
