ORDINANCE NO. 170

An Ordinance Vacating the Alley Contained Within Block 103 on the South Side of Clear Creek in the City of Golden, County of Jefferson and State of Colorado.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Golden, in the County of Jefferson and State of Colorado:

That all of the alley contained and situated between Lots 8, 9, 10 and 11 of that portion of Block 103, located in the original Town, now the City of Golden, on the South Side of Clear Creek, be and the same is hereby vacated and abolished.
