

ORDINANCE NO. 795

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.12.080  
OF THE GOLDEN REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1965,  
AS AMENDED, RELATING TO IMPOUNDMENT FEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The final paragraph of Section 7.12.080 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, as amended, is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

"No dog shall be released from impoundment until the impoundment fee and the boarding fee as set by the City have been paid to the Jefferson County Animal Shelter, Owners of released dogs shall have seven days from the date of release to obtain a valid metal license tag from the city clerk-treasurer for the dog."

Section 2. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
