

ORDINANCE NO. 347

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DOGS, THE OPERATION AND LICENSING OF KENNELS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 339.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO.

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance Number 339 is amended to read as follows: as used in this ordinance, the term "dog" shall be taken to mean a canine animal more than six weeks old; the term "kennel" shall be taken to mean any house, building, apartment, shed, structure, yard, or pen where more than two dogs are kept, harbored or maintained, except as modified by, and subject to the provisions of Section 2 hereof.

Section 2. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 339 is amended to read as follows: the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to or affect:

- (a) the maintenance and operation of any animal hospital or treatment center now maintained and operated by a duly licensed Veterinarian.
- (b) the keeping, harboring or maintaining of two or more dogs as herein defined, provided such dogs are less than 6 weeks old and, provided further, that the owner, keeper, or person in charge thereof shall apply to the City Clerk for a permit so to do. Said permit shall be issued by said City Clerk only by and with approval of the Chief of Police and shall be valid and effective for not more than 6 weeks from date of issue and shall not be renewable.
