

ORDINANCE NO. 873

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO TO HAVE TOWED, IMPOUNDED AND STORED ANY MOTOR VEHICLE ISSUED A PARKING CITATION WHERE THERE ARE TWO OR MORE PRIOR OUTSTANDING UNPAID CITY OF GOLDEN PARKING CITATIONS AGAINST SAID VEHICLE, AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF TOWING, IMPOUNDING AND STORAGE CHARGES, AS WELL AS ANY OTHER PENALTIES PROVIDED FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 are hereby amended by the addition to Chapter 10.76 of Section 10.76.220, as follows:

"10.76.220 Impoundment of motor vehicles authorized for delinquent parking citations.

(a) The Golden Police Department is hereby authorized to cause to be towed, impounded and stored any motor vehicle issued a parking citation when there are two (2) or more City of Golden parking citations against said motor vehicle which are outstanding, delinquent and unpaid at that time.

(b) Such an impounded motor vehicle shall be released only upon payment by the registered owner of the towing, impounding and storage charges, the assessments for the parking violations or the posting of the necessary bond as the case may be, and any other penalties provided for such parking violations.

Section 2. Any ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
