

ORDINANCE NO. 232

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO, TO ORDER THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF ADOPTING THE CITY COUNCIL-CITY MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT AND PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND PLACE OF SAID ELECTION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Golden:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Golden hereby finds and determines that a petition of electors, equal in number to fifteen percent (15%) of the votes cast for all candidates for mayor at the last preceding city election, has been presented and filed with the City Clerk requesting and petitioning the City Council of the City of Golden, and the Mayor thereof to pass an appropriate ordinance and thereby order the submission of the question of adopting the City Council-City Manager form of government to the duly qualified electors of the City of Golden at a special election to be held as provided by an act entitled, "An Act Relating to the Adopting of the City Council-City Manager Form of Government by Cities of the Second Class, and Providing Details in Connection Therewith," approved March 2, 1945, the same being Chapter 245, at page 952 of the Session Laws of 1945 of the State of Colorado.

Section 2. That a special election shall be held for the purpose of the submission of the question of adopting said City Council-City Manager form of government to the duly qualified electors of the City of Golden. That said election shall be held on the 11th day of October, A. D. 1947, in the City of Golden. ~~That the polling places, or places to vote on said question, by said electors, are hereby established and fixed as follows:~~

For Ward No. 1, at City Hall, Golden, Colorado.

For Ward No. 2, at Central School, Golden, Colorado.

For Ward No. 3, at Loveland Fire Hall, Golden, Colorado.

For Ward No. 4, at Recreation Center, 10th and Washington Avenue, Golden, Colorado.

Section 3. The question to be submitted at such special election shall be:

"Shall the City of Golden, Colorado reorganize by adopting the City Council-City Manager form of Government as provided in Session Laws of 1945, Chapter 245.

The form of ballot shall be as follows:

For City Council-City Manager Form.

Against City Council-City Manager Form.

At such election, those who desire to vote in favor of, or against the

proposed reorganization shall place a cross (X) opposite the phrase expressing their choice and deposit the ballot in a separate box to be provided. The election shall in all other respects be conducted, the vote canvassed and the result declared in the same manner as is provided by law for elections of municipal officers in the municipality.

Section 4. The registration and change of residence and the registration books shall be made in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Golden by such Clerk, or his deputy, as provided by law. Electors of the City of Golden, or those desiring to vote at said election may appear before the City Clerk, for original registration, or change of residence, any time up to and including Tuesday, one week before said special municipal election.

Section 5. The judges and clerks of election for each Ward within the City of Golden shall be as follows:

Ward No. 1: Judges, Blanche Fetterman, George Jennings, Edith Larned. Clerks, Mary E. Prisky, Martha C. Bolitho.

Ward No. 2: Judges, Birdie E. Shannon, Jennie Plummer, Elsie Cliff. Clerks, Vera Booth, Jessie S. Rudd.

Ward No. 3: Judges, Esther Vary, Stella F. Stearns, Katherine Jolly. Clerks, Sue E. Ellis, Alga Rice.

Ward No. 4: Judges, Margaret Johnson, Alberta Williams, Lucinda Campbell. Clerks, Arvilla Bennetts, Ruth Todd.

Introduced and read upon first reading by the City of Golden, Colorado on September 9, 1947.

Passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Golden, Colorado and approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of September, 1947.
