

ORDINANCE NO. 599

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$9600.00 FROM THE  
CONTINGENCY FUND TO GENERAL FUND FOR  
AMBULANCE SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Council determines that it is necessary for the general safety and continued health of the citizens of Golden to provide ambulance service to the citizens on a 24-hour basis.

Section 2. In order to provide said service, it will be necessary to expend monies from the City General Fund.

Section 3. The agreement regarding the payment to an ambulance company was signed subsequent to the final adoption of the budget for the year, 1969, and therefore, it is necessary to transfer from the contingency fund the sum of \$9,600.00 since no appropriation was made for ambulance service for the year 1969.

Section 4. The City Manager is, therefore, directed to transfer from the contingency fund the sum of \$9,600.00 and to appropriate in the General Fund the sum of \$9,600.00 for ambulance service for the year 1969.
