

ORDINANCE NO. 602

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE CITY TREASURER AND A DEPARTMENT OF RECORDS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE CITY CLERK; DESIGNATING THE RESPECTIVE DUTIES OF SAID OFFICIALS AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 2.08.060 (a) of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof the following is hereby enacted:

(a) Department of finance which shall be supervised by the City Treasurer. The Treasurer shall have custody of all public monies belonging to or under the control of the city, or any office, department, or agency of the city, and deposit or invest all monies as directed by resolution of the council. All interest earnings shall be the property of the city and shall be accounted for and credited by him to the proper city fund. He shall also collect, and disburse on proper authorization, all monies receivable by the city and all other monies for which the city is responsible for holding in trust, and shall perform such other duties as required by the council, and the manager.

Section 2. Section 2.08.060 of the Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

(h) Department of records which shall be supervised by the City Clerk. The City Clerk shall be custodian of the city seal and shall keep a journal of council proceedings and record in full all ordinances, motions, and resolutions. He shall have power to administer oaths and take acknowledgements under seal of the city, and shall perform such other duties as required by the council, and the manager.
