

ORDINANCE NO. 784

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF MAPLE
STREET LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF GOLDEN

WHEREAS, the Colorado School of Mines has requested vacation of a portion of Maple Street lying adjacent to 19th Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That a portion of Maple Street located within the City of Golden and more specifically described as

that unvacated portion of Maple Street lying between Block 101 and Block 102, South Golden, City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and thoroughfare with an easement reserved over, across, under and upon said vacated street for the installation, repair and maintenance of utilities and appurtenances thereto.
