

**ORDINANCE NO. 243**

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF TWENTY-SECOND (22nd.) STREET, IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

Be It Ordained By the City Council, of the City of Golden, Colorado:

Section 1. That all that portion of Twenty-Second (22nd.) Street, in the City of Golden, extending from the easterly line of Vernon Drive (as platted on the map of Bunzel's Resubdivision of former Blocks four (4), five (5), six (6), a portion of Block two (2), the eastern one-half of Block (8) and the northeastern portion of Block nine (9), Welch's Addition to the City of Golden), to the easterly line of said Bunzel's Resubdivision except that portion within the intersecting boundaries of Table Drive, be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street, highway and thorofare.
