

ORDINANCE NO. 350

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE FORM OF NOMINATING PETITION OF CANDIDATES FOR THE CITY COUNCIL AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 271.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:
