

ORDINANCE NO. 303

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF THE OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That from and after the expiration of the present terms for which they have been respectively appointed, the salaries of the officers and employees of the City of Golden, Colorado, shall be as follows:

Section 2. The compensation of day laborers shall be fixed by the City Manager, but shall not be less than 90 cents nor more than \$1.05 per hour.

Section 3. The above named officers and employees, in addition to compensation as above provided, shall be entitled to receive for special services performed by them such fees as may be provided by ordinance for such special services.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists, and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after the expiration of five days from and after its final passage and publication.
