AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING MARCH 31, 1942.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, That the fiscal year ending the 31 st day of March A. D. 1942 , the much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City of Golden, to-wit:
FIRST-Fifteen Thousand Dollars to provide for sinking funds, for the payment of the outstanding bonds of said City.
SECOND- Six Thousand, Eight Hundred Six and $25 / 100$ Dollars to pay the interest on the outstanding bonds of said City,
$\qquad$ Hundred and no/100 Dollars, to pay salaries and compensations of the officers of said City.
FOURTH- Eight Thousand and no/100 Dollars, to construct and keep in repair the Streets, Aneys, with bridges, of said City, together Cross-walks. The total sum to be spent in the following manner:
A. Four Thousand for repairing pavement.
B. Four Thousand for maintenance.
FIFTH- Ninety Three Hundred and no/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses of ooperatin

SIXTH-Three Thousand and no/100 Dollars, to pay the General not otherwise provided for.
SEVENTH. Twenty-One undred and no/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses of the Police and Fire De-
partment of said City, as follows: EIGR Dollars to pay the expens of the Golden Park and Cemetery of said city.
$\qquad$ Dollars, to pay the expenses of Lighting the streets of said City. TENTH- Three Hundred and no/ 100 Dollars, to pay the
