ORDINANCE 187

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE
ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
MARCH 31, 1942.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLD-
EN, That the fiscal year ending the
31st day of March, A. D. 1942, the
following sums of money, or as
much thereof as may be necessary,
are hereby appropriated to defray
the expenses and liabilities of the
City of Golden, to-wit:

FIRST—Fifteen Thousand Dollars
to provide for sinking funds, for
the payment of the outstanding
bonds of said City.

SECOND— Six Thousand, Eight
Hundred Six and 25/100 Dollars to
pay the interest on the outstanding
bonds of said City.

THIRD— Nine Thousand, Nine
Hundred and no/100 Dollars, to pay
salaries and compensations of the
officers of said City.

FOURTH— Eight Thousand and
no/100 Dollars, to construct and
keep in repair the Streets, Alleys,
and bridges, of said City, together
with Culverts, Side-walks and
Cross-walks. The total sum to be
spent in the following manner:

A. Four Thousand for repairing
pavement.

B. Four Thousand for mainten-
ance.

FIFTH— Ninety Three Hundred
and no/100 Dollars, to pay the ex-
penses of operating the Water
Works of said City.

SIXTH— Three Thousand and
no/100 Dollars, to pay the General
and Incidental expense of said City,
not otherwise provided for.

SEVENTH— Twenty-One undred
and no/100 Dollars, to pay the ex-
penses of the Police and Fire De-
partment of said City, as follows:

EIGHT— Eleven Hundred and
no/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses
of the Golden Park and Cemetery
of said City.

NINTH— Twenty-Five Hundred
Dollars, to pay the expenses of
Lighting the Streets of said City.

TENTH— Three Hundred and
no/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses
of recreation of said City.
