AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTION OF BOYD STREET, CITY OF GOLDEN, COUNTY OF

JEFFERSON, COLORADO.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That portion of Boyd Street described hereinbelow, City of Golden, County of Jefferson, wurado, be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and thoroughfare.

Beginning at the East quarter corner of Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 70 West of the 6th F.M.; thence South 89 degrees 57' West along the South line of Lot 1, Block 1, Clark's Garden Addition to the City of Golden, a distance of 130.0 feet to the true point of beginning: thence North 0 degrees 44.5' East along the West line of Blocks 1 and 2 of said Clark's Garden Addition a distance of 962.10 feet to the North line of Lot 11, Block 2, Clark's Garden Addition; thence North 89 degrees 57' West a distance of 22.0 feet; thence South 0 degrees 38.5' East s distance of 962.1 feet to the true point of beginning; except that portion of High Street erclosed by the afore described tract.
