ORDINANCE NO. 237

AN ORDINANCE VACATING
TABLE STREET, IN THE CITY OF
GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOL-
DEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all that portion
of Table Street, lying between
Twenty-first Street and Twenty-
third Street, in the City of Golden,
be and the same is hereby vacated
and abolished as a public street and
thorofare.

Section 2. That the fee simple
title thereto shall vest as by law
in such cases made and provided.
