ORDINANCE NO. 202

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CHILDREN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of 16 years to be or remain upon any of the streets, alleys, or other public places in the City of Golden, between the hours of 10 o'clock P. M. and 5 o'clock A. M. unless such child has a reasonable excuse therefor or un-less such child is accompanied by a parent, guardian or other person having legal care and custody of such child.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any parent, guardian or other person having the legal care and custody of any child under the age of 16 years to allow or permit any such child to be or remain upon any street, alley or other public place subsequent to the hour of 10 o'clock by Monda with the hour of P. M. and prior to the hour of 5 o'clock A. M. of the next day, unless there exists a reasonable excuse therefor.

Section 3: Any person who shall section 3: Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 2 hereof shall, upon conviction, be fined in a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100).

Section 4: Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is the support for the immediate preserved.

gency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preser-vation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect im-mediately upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
