And Whereas, the Water and Sewer Utility Fund unappropriated surplus has been found to have a surplus of \$4,228.88 over and above the anticipated expenditures for the

And Whereas, the amounts of the respective requested transfers of funds are less than the anticipated surplus together with the requested transfers the City Council of the transfers, the City Council of the said City upon the request of the Budget Authority, hereby authorizes and orders the following transfers of funds to the designated depart-

ments as follows, to-wit:

1. Water Maintenance in the amount of \$1,319.02.

2. To pay the interest on the outstanding Water Bonds of said City in the amount of \$85.86.
