

ORDINANCE NO. 659

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$50,000.00 FROM THE CONTINGENCY FUND AND \$10,000.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS AND APPROPRIATING \$60,000.00 FOR CONDEMNATION OF THE SITE KNOWN AS THE POST OFFICE SITE LOCATED IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN:

Section 1. The Council determines that certification by the City Manager shows there is available the sum of \$10,000.00 from unappropriated surpluses and additional revenues which revenues exist by reason of the surplus existing at the end of 1971 over and above that estimated for the 1972 budget.

Section 2. Since the preparation of the budget in 1972, it has become necessary for the City of Golden to expend the sum of \$50,000.00 from the contingency fund for purposes of depositing in Court the sum necessary to obtain the collapsed post office site by reason of a condemnation action during which the Court has ordered that to obtain possession, the City must deposit said \$60,000.00.

Section 3. It is necessary to deposit the said \$60,000.00 into the District Court in and for the County of Jefferson, State of Colorado.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from the contingency fund the sum of \$50,000.00 and to transfer from unappropriated surpluses the sum of \$10,000.00, and to appropriate within the capital budget under an item to be designated "Collapsed Post Office Site Condemnation Cost", the sum of \$60,000.00, said transfer to occur within the budget for the calendar year 1972.
