N ORDINANCE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING

MARCH 31, 1945. Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Golden, That the Fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, A. D. 1945, the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be noney, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray the expenses and liabilities of the City of Golden, to-wit: FIRST: Fleven Thousand Dollars to provide for sinking funds, for the

payment of the outstanding bonds of said City.
SECOND: Four Thousand Six tundred Fifty-Eight and 24/100 Dolhars, to pay the interest on the outstanding bonds of said City.
THIRD: Twelve Thousand Seven

THIRD: Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty and no/100 Dollars, to pay salaries and compensations of the officers of said City.

FOURTH: Eleven Thousand Six Hundred and no/100 Dollars, to construct and keep in repair the Streets, Alleys and Bridges, of said City, together with Culverts, Sidewalks and Cross-walks. The total sum to be sucht in the following sum to be spent in the following manner:

A. Seven Thousand Six Hundred Dollars for Street Maintenance.
B. Four Thousand Dollars for re-

pairing pavement.

Parring pavement.
FIFTH: Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars, to pay the Water expenses of said fity, not otherwise provided for the total sum to be spent in the following manner:

A. Eight Thousand Five Hundred Pollars for Water Works Mainten-

ance.

B. One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars for purchase of water. SIXTH: Nine Thousand and no/100 SIXTH: Nine Thousand and no/100 hollars, to pay the General Incidental expenses of said City, not otherwise provided for. Total sum to be spent in the following manner:

A. Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars for General & Incidental ex-

penses.

B. One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars for the Zoning of the City.
C. One Thousand Dollars for the

planning of projects.
SEVENTH: Four Thousand Two
Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses of the Police and Fire Departments of said City, as follows:

Police Department \$1600.00
EIGHT: One Thousand One Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars to pay
the expenses of the Golden Park
and Cemetery of said City.
NINTH: One Thousand Eight Hundred and no/100 Dollars, to pay the
expenses of lighting the Streets of
said City.

said City. TENTH: One Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars, to pay the expenses of recreation of said City. ELEVENTH: There is hereby ap-

propriated, for use during the fiscal

year ending March 31, 1945, from the sewer fund created by Ordinances Number 191 and 192 the sum of Twenty-Three Hundred Twenty-Four and 44/100 Dollars.

Whereas, in the opinion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
