

ORDINANCE NO. 1007

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF
VERNON STREET LYING SOUTH OF 18TH STREET,
WITHIN THE CITY OF GOLDEN

WHEREAS, Deewitt M. Baulch has made application for the vacation of Vernon Street lying south of 18th Street within the City of Golden; and

WHEREAS, public hearings on the vacation have been held before the Planning Commission and City Council and the application is complete and in accordance with the vacation procedures and regulations of the City of Golden.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The hereinafter described property located in the City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, and described as:

Quarter of Section 34, T3S, R70W,
situated Northeast of Lot 1, Block L, in
Kinney Addition

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
