

ORDINANCE NO. 957

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COLORADO LIQUOR CODE AND ELIMINATING THE DISTANCE RESTRICTIONS FROM SCHOOLS, ETC., FOR HOTEL AND RESTAURANT LICENSES ONLY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 are hereby amended by the addition of Section 4.84.020, as follows:

"4.84.020 Distance Restrictions for Hotel and Restaurant Licenses. The five hundred foot (500') distance restrictions as provided by Section 12-47-138(d) of the Colorado Liquor Code for hotel and restaurant licenses only, from schools, colleges, universities or seminaries as specified therein, are hereby eliminated. Notwithstanding the provisions hereof, the City Council shall, in any case where a proposed hotel or restaurant license is located within the prescribed distance restrictions of said Section 12-47-138(d), make a specific finding as to the impact of granting the license on said school, college, university or seminary, as the case may be, and may deny said license where said impact is not compatible with the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood or the desires of the adult inhabitants thereof."

Section 2. Any ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
