WHEREAS, certain employees of the City of Golden have terminated their employment with said City and other employees have signified their intention to terminate such employment and secure other employment, advancing as reasons therefor their inability to meet rising living costs on the scale of salaries and wages now being paid by said City and,

WHEREAS it is becoming increasingly difficult to employ qualfied personnel at portent and easeing wage and salary rates and,

WHEREAS, by reason of the foregoing conditions and circumstances, the City Council of the City of Golden finds that it may become necessity to cirtail the performance of essential governmental services and that by reason thereof the efficienoperation of the manicipal government will be inneited.

NOW THEREFORE, the Ci y council of the Ci y of tolden, thus and determines that the proper operation of the manicipal government, the public peace, health and safety is threatened; that an emergency exists and that appropriate increases in wages and salaries of city officials and employees are necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT OR-BAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLO-RADO:

SECTION 1. That from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the salaries of the officers and employees of the City of Golden, Colerado shall be as follows:
