## ORDINANCE NO. 576

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UN-AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UN-LAWFUL TO SELL OR GIVE FER-MENTED MALT BEVERAGES TO ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN AND MAKING IT UN-LAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO OBTAIN FERMENTED MALT BEV-ERAGES BY MEANS OF FALSE UNDERTISEIGATION CARDS IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN. COLORADO:

Section 1. Secton 4.64.050. Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby amended to read:

"Persons to whom sale is prohibited. It shall be unlawful to sell or give malt, vinous or spirituous liquors to son habitual drunkard or minor, under the age of twenty-one years, knowing him or her to be such a min-Or to sell or give fermented malt beverages to any minor under the age of eighteen."

Section 2. Section 4.64.060, Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby amended to read:

"Minor obtaining liquor under false identification. It shall be unlawful for any minor to obtain or attempt to obtain malt, vinous, spirituous liquors, or fermented malt beverages by means of falsification of any records or means of identification, or by the presentation of false, fraudulent, count-

erfeit, stolen, misappropriated or otherwise obtained credentials." Adopted and approved and ordered published this 12th day of January,
