ORDINANCE REVISING THE WATER AND SEWER RATES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO.

Section 1. Section 13.08.010, Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, is hereby repealed and reinacted as follows:

13.08.010 WATER RATE SCHEDULE - Domestic and commercial users billed quarterly. There is hereby established a water rate schedule I which shall apply to all water delivered to domestic or comercial users within the City Limits of Golden quarterly billed on the first days of January, April, July, and October, except as billed under Section 13.08.020 nereof:

There is hereby established a water rate schedule V which shall apply to water delivered to the Pleasant View Water and Sanitation District during all months of the year as quarterly billed on the first days of April, July, October, and January of each year:

Section 6. Section 13.08.060, Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965, is hereby repealed and reinacted as follows.

13.08 060 TABLE I MINIMUM QUAR-TERLY CHARGES INSIDE THE CITY. There is bereby established table I relating to the minimum quarterly charges for uses within the City Limits, which able is based upon the size of meter installed, as a measure of available water to each user. A meter installed in a service line shall be of a size commensurate with the delivery canacity of the service line: a maximum difference of a single incremate of pipe diameter will be permissible

Section 7. Section 13.08.080. Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby re-nealed and reinacted as follows:

13 08.080 CHARGE FOR FIRE PRO-TECTION. There is hereby established a charge for the availability of water for the purpose of fire protection by means of a summetered sprinkler system—A rate of \$.55 per thousand square feet of total floor area protected per quarter. Where such fire protection systems are metered by a meter in the service line

shall not apply.

Section 8. Section 13.08.120, Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby repealed and reinacted as follows:

13.08.120 SEWER RATE SCHEDULE VI — CHARGES FOR USERS INSIDE CITY. There is hereby established sewer rate schedule VI, which schedule shall set the charges for the use of sanitary sewers and sewage system by all users in the City of Golden are quarterly billed on the first days of January, April, July and October, subject to maximum quarterly charges set forth in Section 13.08 .-130 hereof:

SEWER RATE SCHEDULE VI Minimum quarterly fee Charge for sewage in excess of 9,000 callons—1/5th of the charge set forth herein for all such water used in excess of 9, 000 gallons.

Section 9. Section 13.08.130, Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby resealed and reinacted as follows:

13.08.130 MAXIMU'M SEWER CHARG-ES. It is hereby established a maximum sewer charge for all residential users of the sanitary sewers and sewage system as follows:

(a) Single-family residential users: The sewer charge as determined by use of schedule VI as quarterly billed on the first day of April shall become the maxmum sanitary sewer charge for each quarerly billing as the first day of July, and October of the same calendar year and January of the following calendar year. in case the water usage declines in the latter quarter so that the charge so de ermined by use of schedule VI is less than that charge of April 1st, the lesser charze shall apply except in no case shall the charge be less than \$4.50 per quarter.

(b) Other residential users: The sewer charge as determined by the use of schedule VI as quarterly billed on the first day of April, multiplied by a factor of one and one-quarter shall become the maximum sanitary sewer charge for each quarterly billing on the first days of 1967.

all water use is so metered the above rate | July and October of the same calendar year, and January of the following calen-dar year. In case that the charge determined by use of schedule VI is less than that of April 1st, the lesser charge shall apply except in no case shall the charge

be less than \$4.50 per quarter.
(c) Irrigation: No sewer charge shall be made under this section for irrigation water which is metered separately and used solely for irrigation pursuant to Section 13.08.030 hereof.

Section 10. The effective date of this ordinance shall be January 1, 1968.
