

ORDINANCE NO. 641

641

AN ORDINANCE REAPPORTIONING THE CITY OF GOLDEN, ESTABLISHING
NEW WARD BOUNDARIES, AND REPEALING SECTIONS OF THE GOLDEN
REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1965 IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 1.04.030 Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby
repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

1.04.030 FIRST WARD BOUNDARY DESIGNATED

That portion of the City lying southerly and westerly of the following described
line shall be designated as Ward 1:

Commencing at a point where the centerline of U. S. Highway 6 crosses the North-
South centerline of Section 33, T3S, R70W; thence South and Easterly along the
centerline of U. S. Highway 6 to the intersection of 19th Street; thence Easterly
along 19th Street to the intersection of Jackson Street; thence Southerly along
Jackson Street to the intersection of Jackson Street and Ford Street; thence
along Ford Street also known as the South Golden Road in a Southerly direction
to Johnson Drive; thence along Johnson Drive in a Southerly direction to its
intersection with the South property line of the Earle Johnson School property;
thence East along Johnson School property; thence East along said South
property line to the North-South centerline of the NW 1/4 of Section 2,
Township 4 South, Range 70 West; thence South along said centerline and its
extension South to the existing City limits or any future Southerly extension
thereof.

Section 2. Section 1.04.040 Golden Revised Ordinances 1965 is hereby
repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

1.04.040 SECOND WARD BOUNDARY DESIGNATED

That portion of the City lying southerly and easterly of the following described
line shall be designated as Ward 2:

Commencing at a point on the East City limits where the centerline of 16th
Street if extended would meet the East City limits; thence Westerly along 16th
Street extended and 16th Street to East Street; thence Southerly along
East Street to 17th Street; thence Westerly along 17th Street to Jackson Street;
thence Southerly along Jackson Street to the intersection of Jackson Street
and Ford Street; thence along Ford Street also known as the South Golden Road
in a Southerly direction to Johnson Drive; thence along Johnson Drive in a
Southerly direction to its intersection with the South property line of the
Earle Johnson School property; thence East along said South property line to
the North-South centerline of the NW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 4 South, Range
70 West; thence South along said centerline and its extension South to the ex-
isting City limits or any future Southerly extension thereof.

Section 3. Section 1.04.050 Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby
repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

1.04.050 THIRD WARD BOUNDARY DESIGNATED

That portion of the City lying Easterly and Northerly of the following described
line shall be designated as Ward 3.

Commencing at a point where the centerline of 13th Street (or West 32nd Avenue
as the case may be) and the Easterly City limits join; thence Westerly along
13th Street to the centerline of Jackson Street; thence Northerly along the
centerline of Jackson Street to its intersection with the Northerly line of
Lot 9, Block 8, Golden Park Addition extended; thence Westerly along the
Northerly line of Lots 6, 7, 8 and 9, Block 8, Golden Park Addition extended
to its intersection with the centerline of Washington Avenue; thence Northerly
along the centerline of Washington Avenue and the centerline of County Highway
No. 93 to its intersection with the existing Northerly City limits or any future
Northerly extension thereof.

Section 4. Section 1.04.060 Golden Revised Ordinances of 1965 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

1.04.060 FOURTH WARD BOUNDARY DESIGNATED

The balance of the City of Golden shall be designated as Ward 4 which shall be encompassed by a line described as follows:

Commencing at that point on the Easterly City limits where 16th Street extended meets said City limits; thence Westerly along 16th Street extended and 16th Street to East Street; thence Southerly along East Street to 17th Street; thence Westerly along 17th Street to Jackson Street; thence Southerly along Jackson Street to the intersection of 19th Street; thence Westerly along the centerline of 19th Street to the intersection of U. S. Highway No. 6; thence Northerly and Westerly along the centerline of U. S. Highway No. 6 to the point where it crosses Clear Creek; thence along the boundary of the City of Golden for all that area situate Westerly of U. S. Highway No. 6 as said boundary exists now in the NW 1/4 of Section 33, T3S, R70W; thence along said boundary of the City of Golden in a Northerly and Easterly direction as said boundary exists now or may be in the future extended, to the intersection of said boundary and County Highway 93; thence Southerly along the centerline of County Highway 93 to Washington Avenue and along Washington Avenue to the point where the North line of Lots 6, 7, 8 and 9, Block 8, Golden Park Addition as extended would meet Washington Avenue; thence along the Northerly boundary extended of Lots 6, 7, 8 and 9, Block 8, Golden Park Addition to the intersection of the centerline of Jackson Street extended; thence Southerly along the centerline of Jackson Street to 13th Street; thence along the centerline of 13th Street (continuing along the centerline of West 32nd Avenue as necessary) to the East boundary of the City of Golden as it now exists or may be extended; thence along the Easterly boundary of the City of Golden to the point of beginning.
