sixty-six (66) feet are dedicated to the public use, provided, cated to the public use, provided, however, that the City Council shall not approve any such plat, subdivision, resubdivision or annexation wherein the street or streets are extensions, con-tinuations or elongations of a street or streets previously dedicated having a width of sixtysix (66) feet or more, unless said connecting street or streets are of a corresponding or great-
