

ORDINANCE NO. 709

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$10,000.00 FROM
CONTINGENCY AND APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00
TO THE TUCKER GULCH CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
PROJECT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. The Council determines that certification by the City Manager shows there is available unencumbered sums of \$10,000.00 in contingency.

SECTION 2. The appropriation of \$10,000.00 from Contingency will provide sufficient funds necessary for the continuation of this most necessary project.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is directed to transfer from Contingency the sum of \$10,000.00 and appropriate to the Tucker Gulch Capital Improvement Project the sum of \$10,000.00, said transfer to occur within the budget for the calendar year 1974.
