

ORDINANCE NO. 689

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$40,000.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS AND APPROPRIATING \$40,000.00 FOR THE GOLDEN POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TRANSFERRING \$1,600.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS AND APPROPRIATING \$1,600.00 FOR THE SPECIAL ACCOUNT FOR URBAN DRAINAGE STUDY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Council determines that certification by the City Manager shows there is available a sum in excess of \$41,600.00 from unappropriated surpluses and additional revenues which exist over and above that estimated for the 1973 budget.

Section 2. Since the preparation of the 1973 budget, the City of Golden has found it necessary to expend a total of \$40,000.00 for salary increases, purchase of office equipment and miscellaneous other expenses to upgrade the Golden Police Department.

Section 3. That it is necessary to appropriate \$1,600.00 for the special account for Urban Drainage Study to pay the City of Golden's share for participation in the master drainage plan for Lena Gulch being prepared by the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to transfer from unappropriated surplus the sum of \$41,600.00 and to appropriate within the Police Department budget the sum of \$40,000.00 and to appropriate \$1,600.00 for the special account for Urban Drainage Study, such transfers to occur within the budget for the calendar year 1973.
