

ORDINANCE NO. 446  
AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF CRAWFORD STREET ON THE NORTH SIDE OF CLEAR CREEK IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, STATE OF COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all that portion of Crawford Street lying between the Northerly line of Clear Creek and a line across Crawford Street, said line being parallel to and 164.12 feet Southeasterly of the center line of 10th Street, in the City of Golden, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, be and the same is hereby vacated and abolished as a public street and thoroughfare.

Section 2. That there is reserved hereby to the City of Golden, an easement and right of way for the installation and maintenance of utility lines and appurtenances thereto, in, upon, over and across the aforesaid portion of Crawford Street vacated lying Northerly of the Northwesterly right of way line of the Farmers Highline Canal.
