

**ORDINANCE NO. 310**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 242 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 49.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 3, Ordinance No. 242 of the City of Golden is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The City Clerk-Treasurer may require the premises to be occupied by the licensee to be inspected for the purpose of ascertaining if such premises are sanitary and in reasonably safe condition for occupancy. The City Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to issue a license to such applicant upon payment of license fee of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars; provided, however, that if upon inspection, any such premises are found to be unsanitary or unsafe or if extraordinary fire hazards are found to exist, the City Clerk-Treasurer may require such changes or alterations in the premises as may be reasonably necessary before issuing such license; provided further, that no license shall issue to any person, firm or corporation to engage in the plumbing business, until the person, firm or corporation shall have entered into and furnished a bond to said City, with good and sufficient surety or sureties to be approved by the City Council in the penal sum of five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars; conditioned to comply with all requirements of the Building Code, Sanitary Code, regulations of the Building Inspector, and with all the ordinances of the City of Golden relating to water and sewer.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 49 and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
