

ORDINANCE NO. 996

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GOLDEN REVISED
ORDINANCES WITH REGARD TO THE SYSTEM
DEVELOPMENT FEE SCHEDULE FOR LAUNDROMATS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN,
COLORADO:

Section 1. Sub-section (7) of Section 13.04.040 of the
Golden Revised Ordinance of 1965 is hereby repealed and re-
enacted as follows:

"13.04.040 System Development Fee
Schedule. . . .

(7) Processed water - Where processed
water is used in conjunction with a
commercial/industrial use multiply the
above basic building rate EQR by 2.0;
laundromats shall have an EQR rate of 0.2
per washing machine."

Section 2. Any ordinances or portions or ordinances in
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
