

**ORDINANCE NO. 244**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BICYCLES, PROVIDING FOR LICENSES THEREFOR AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, to operate or use any bicycle upon any street, within the City of Golden, without a license first had and obtained from the City of Golden so to do, as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation owning or operating a bicycle on any street within the City of Golden shall on or before the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, A. D. 1948, apply to the City Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Golden for a license therefor, which application shall state the name of the applicant, the address of the applicant, the make of the bicycle, the size of the wheel, the color of the vehicle and the serial number of the frame if such there be and such other information as may be required by the City Clerk-Treasurer.

Section 3. The City Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to issue a license to such applicant upon payment of license fee of fifty (.50c) cents.

Section 4. The City Clerk-Treasurer upon proper application and payment of the above fee shall furnish to the Applicant a metal tag, the number of such tag to correspond with the number of the license. The metal tag to be attached to the bicycle by the applicant; if the tag shall be lost or removed it shall be replaced immediately by the owner or operator by making application as for a new tag.

Section 5. Every person, firm or corporation operating or using any bicycle upon any street in the City of Golden who shall fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any of the terms or provisions of this ordinance or who shall violate any such terms or provisions shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction be fined not less than One Dollar nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars.

Section 6. All licenses shall expire on the Thirty-first day of March following issuance of such license and no rebate or credit shall be allowed for licenses issued or used for a portion of a year only.

Section 7. Licenses shall be non-transferable.

Section 8. It is hereby declared that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and publication.
