

**ORDINANCE NO. 330**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN EASEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOLDEN-RALSTON CREEK AND CHURCH DITCH COMPANY, THE FARMERS RESERVOIR AND IRRIGATION COMPANY, AND THE CITY OF GOLDEN:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Whereas the Golden-Ralston Creek and Church Ditch Company, The Farmers Reservoir and Irrigation Company and the City of Golden, Colorado, a municipal corporation, have entered into an easement agreement, dated May 8, 1952, for the use of the head gate of the Golden-Ralston Creek and Church Ditch Company and the Farmers Reservoir and Irrigation Company, by the City of Golden and providing for the payment of said use by said City of Golden, now therefore, the Mayor of said City of Golden, is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of said City the aforesaid easement agreement.
