**ORDINANCE NO. 257**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ZONING THE CITY OF GOLDEN; ESTABLISHING A BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND AMENDING SECTION 11, OF ORDINANCE NUMBERED 256, AND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 240.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

*Section 11*

Section 1. That Paragraph 1, Section 11 of Ordinance Number 256 of the Ordinances of the City of Golden, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: A Board of Adjustments is hereby established. The word "Board" when used in this section shall be construed to mean the Board of Adjustment. The Board shall consist of Nine (9) members, and shall be composed of all the members of the Planning Commission of the City of Golden.

*Section 2*

Section 2. That Section 1 of Ordinance Numbered 240 of the Ordinances of the City of Golden, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: There is hereby created the Planning Commission, which shall be appointed by the Mayor upon confirmation by the City Council, the membership shall consist of Nine (9) citizens of the City of Golden, the term of office shall be two years except the members appointed under this ordinance for the first term which shall expire on the 31st day of December, A. D. 1949.
