

ORDINANCE NO. 222

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK NUMBERED NINE (9), BARBER'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GOLDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

That all that portion of the public alley in Block Numbered Nine (9) Barber's Addition to the City of Golden and lying between Lots numbered Seven (7), Eight (8), and Nine (9), on one side of said alley and Lots numbered Ten (10), Eleven (11), and Twelve (12), on the other side of said alley in Block numbered Nine (9) situate partly in Barber's Addition and partly in Barber's Third Addition to the City of Golden, be and is hereby vacated and abolished as a public alley.
