ORDINANCE NO. 270

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SEWER SYSTEMS OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN AND FIXING CERTAIN CONNECTION AND USE CHARGES WITHIN SAID CITY AND AMENDING SECTION 1 B, OF OR-

DINANCE NUMBER 227.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOL-

DEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 1 B of Ordinance Number 227 of the Ordinances of the City of Golden, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

From and after the and adoption of this ordinance, the quarterly rates and charges for the use of the sanitary sewers and sewerage systems of the City of Golden, by property situated within the corporate boundaries thereof, through and by means of any connections therewith, whether heretofore or hereafter made, shall be as follows, to-wit:

A. For private dwellings, public buildings, schools and public institutions connected with the Golden Water System the quarterly rates

and charges shall be as follows:
1. Quarter ending December 31, fifty (50%) per cent of charge for water as metered during said

quarter.

Quarter ending March 31, fifty (50%) per cent of charge for water as metered during said quarter.

3. Quarter ending June 30, fifty (50%) per cent of average charge for water as metered in

the preceding quarters ending December 31 and March 31.
4. Quarter ending September 30, fifty (50%) per cent of average charge for water as me ered in the preceding quarters ending December 31 and March 31.

For private dwellings, public buildings, schools and public institutions not connected with the Golden Water System or private dwellings not connected with the Golden Water System for the preceeding quarters ending December 31 and March 31 the quarterly rates and charges shall be as follows: 1. One (\$1.00) bollar per month.

For stores, shops, business C. For stores, snops, business houses, restaurants, taverns, hotels, apartment houses, rooming houses, garages, filling stations, manufacturing plants, industrial institutions and all other connections and

usages the quarterly rates and charges shall be as follows:

1. Fifty (50%) per cent of the charge for water as evidenced by meter readings for water used upon said premises, provided however that a minimum charge of One (\$1.00) Dollar per month shall be collected.

The rates and charges herein provided shall become effective on the First day of October, 1949. The rates and charges herein above specified shall be due and payable quarterly commencing with the quarter ending December 31, 1949 and each quarter thereafter.

Section 2. Whereas, in the opin-ion of the City Council, an emergency exists, and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days after its final passage and publication.
